

Kumpan electric introduces its new E-Scooter model *54 inspire*

- 54 inspire is the first vehicle of the 54i family. It was envisioned for the young and the young-at-heart e-mobility fans.
- The 54i family is the evolution from the Kumpan electric model 1954 Ri and it consists in the four new models inspire, iconic, impulse and ignite.
- The 54i series comes with a variety of new updates for more comfort as well as improved driving capability.

With the new Kumpan electric inspire, the e-bility GmbH presents the first Electric Scooter model of the new 54i family. The inspire has a top speed of 45 km/h and a lower seat height than the previous Kumpan models. It seeks to impress its drivers with its manoeuvrability and smart technology. The e-bility-team based in Remagen, Germany is also presenting the brand new bright yellow vehicle colour.

When developing the inspire, Kumpan focused on the needs of those consumers, who were looking for a more affordable, yet high-quality entry-level model. The new features include smaller 12-inch tyres, a lower, more comfortable seat and improved ergonomics. The newly developed LED headlight (optional) and turn signals for better illumination and visibility at night, lastly a brand new Kumpan Key App.

In addition, the features of the old 1954RI are kept: The new Kumpan 54 inspire is controlled via an intuitive 7-inch touch-up display, keyless start that also offers three different driving modes (Comfort, Eco, Rain). The storage space holds up to three batteries and luggage. Equipped with one battery (the "power pack"), the inspire travels up to 62 kilometres (under ideal conditions; range can vary depending on territory, weight or weather). The inspire carries an engine power of 3 kW. The price starts at €3,999.

54i family overview

The model series consists of the four models *inspire*, *iconic*, *impulse* and *ignite* for different use cases and target groups. The first two models *inspire* and *iconic* (an optimised version of the 1954 Ri model) belong to vehicle group L1e and is now ready to order. The first batch can be delivered beginning of June. The *impulse* (70km/h) and *ignite* (100 km/h) models fall into the L3e class and will be launched in the third quarter of 2020.

Accessories

In order for drivers to adapt their Kumpan to their wishes and driving habits, Kumpan offers various accessories to individualize the four models of the 54i family.

An electric top case can be fitted to each of the model variants. If you want to give your Kumpan special protection, you can now have a 360-degree crash bar fitted to your vehicle.

Long-distance pilots will be delighted with the optional windscreen, while shopping bags or saddle bags can be hung from the aluminium hook of the legroom.

All e-scooters are designed, developed and produced in Germany and allow ranges of up to 186 kilometres (this corresponds to a range of up to 62 km per battery according to test standard EVE 134/2014). Besides the end customer business, Kumpan is also active in the B2B sector: Kumpan scooters and technology are used as white label solutions by companies offering e-scooter sharing, e.g. local energy suppliers or utility companies. At the end of 2019 Kumpan was able to secure a new round of financing in the 8-digit range - Innoenergy is one of these investors. With the help of the investment Kumpan took over the scooter brand Scooser from Berlin. Kumpan electric is available in Germany, France, the Netherlands, Belgium, Austria, Switzerland, Spain, the USA and Canada.
